### IFCP Elects Officers at ICAC Plenary Meeting in Lubbock, TX

**Mr. Zbigniew Roskwitalski** was elected Chairman of the International Forum for Cotton Promotion (IFCP) for a fourth consecutive term at the Annual Business Meeting of the membership held in Lubbock, TX on September 24, 2010. Mr. Roskwitalski is the Executive Director of the Izba Bawelny w Gdyni (Gdynia Cotton Association). The meeting ran concurrently with the ICAC 69<sup>th</sup> Plenary Meeting.

Remaining in the role of Vice Chairman is **Nayan C. Mirani**, Vice President of the Cotton Association of India (CAI), and **Jan B. Wellmann** of Bremer Baumwollbörse (Bremen Cotton Exchange) continues as Treasurer. The Immediate Past Chairman is **Mark Messura**, Executive Vice President, Global Product Supply Chain Division, for U.S. based Cotton Incorporated.

**Jeffrey Silberman** continues in the post of Executive Director of the IFCP. He is also the Chairperson of the Textile Development and Marketing Department at the Fashion Institute of Technology (FIT) in New York City.

According to Mr. Roskwitalski, "I am pleased to accept this honor once again and look forward to fulfilling the responsibilities of the post by moving the organization forward."
