Itinerary: Old and Modern parts of the city of Tashkent

Please note: The bus will pick up participants from the International and Navruz hotels only. The tour starts at 09:30 am with a journey through Tashkent's historic heart, beginning at Khast Imam Square. Guests will explore the Mausoleum of Kaffal Shashi, the Barak Khan Madrassah, and the Tilla Sheikh Mosque. A highlight of this visit is the library, home to one of the oldest copies of Osman's Koran, a priceless relic from the 8th century. The journey then leads to Chorsu Bazaar, Tashkent's oldest marketplace, Jumah Mosque, and the Kukaldosh Mausoleum.

The group will stop for lunch at Beshkazan, one of Tashkent's oldest and most beloved restaurants, then continues with a brief visit to the Minor Mosque, also known as the "White Mosque." In the afternoon, the tour shifts focus to the modern side of Tashkent, with visits to the Independence Square, Amir Timur Square, and the Museum of the Timurids.

There will be visits to a cotton cluster and a textile enterprise. As the sun sets, the day will conclude with a final meal at a distinguished local restaurant, leaving guests with a lasting impression of Uzbekistan's vibrant cuisine. Drop off at the hotels will be at 8:00 pm.
