He carried out his PhD work at University of Ghent (Belgium) with the team of the laboratory of ethnobotany and subtropical agriculture. He has participated in the drafting of several sub-regional projects including: Strengthening agricultural innovation systems to promote sustainable agro-sylvo-pastoralism in the northern region of Cameroon project (2021-2024); and the Innovation for Adaptation to Climate Change project (2022-2027).

He has held several positions of responsibility, notably as Head of the Research Centre at the national level in Cameroon, and as the focal point for certain regional initiatives including CORAF, PRASAC, and ASARECA. Dr ir Bourou has also taken part in a number of international conferences and symposia and benefited from several training courses in Africa, America, Europe, and Asia. He is the author or co-author of 20 peer-reviewed articles.
